How do I pay by check?

When will I know that payment has been processed and that I am registered?

Once payment has been processed we will send an email to the email address listed on the registration form. This generally takes about 3-4 business days, but may take longer around the dates when the registration fee increases due to the number of registrations we receive at that time.

What does it cost to register for the conference?

\$350, if paid by ~~June 26, 2009~~ July 10, 2009

\$415, if paid between ~~June 27, 2009~~ July 11, 2009 and October 2, 2009

\$440, if paid between October 3, 2009 and November 7, 2009

\$465, if paid after November 7, 2009

What does the registration fee include?

Badge (required for admittance to sessions), four breakfasts for the registered participant, mid-morning and afternoon coffee breaks, a copy of the Conference Program, and a copy of the Conference Proceedings.
